



Total Futbol COVID Scrimmage/Game Protocol

Total Futbol is committed to the safety and well-being of its players, parents, and staff. The protocols listed below are to be followed in addition to the state guidelines where the game is taking place.

Scrimmage and Game Protocol

Before/During Competition

- Any coach, player or referee who tests positive within 14 days prior to a competition or is awaiting results of a COVID-19 test, can NOT participate.
- Players and coaches must wear masks/face coverings to and from the parking area to the fields and on the sideline, and maintain social distance before, after and during games.
- Parents/spectators must wear masks/face coverings at all times and social distance from others.
- Player gear must be spaced 6 feet apart from each other behind the bench.
- Prior to competition coaches are REQUIRED to ask players a series of COVID exposure questions.
 - These questions will be answered using the Teamsnap [Health Check](#) function in the app.
 - Players are expected to have their temperature taken prior to arriving at the field. If a player's temperature registers 100.4 or higher, the player can not participate in the game — NO exceptions.
- Players MUST wear a face covering while on the bench and maintain 6 ft. of distancing from each other.
- Coaches must maintain 10 ft from opposing coach and referee.
- Only the coach is permitted to handle warm-up equipment.
- Coaches must wipe down the metal benches players will utilize during the game (if applicable).
- Only the team manager/administrator can handle player cards.
- Substitutions must be made from in front of the bench, not the center line, so players can maintain social distance.
- No international walkouts are permitted.

- No physical contact between players outside of game play.
- Use hand sanitizer often — before the game, before/after substitutions, during halftime, after the game. Players should bring their own sanitizer to use.
- No sharing of water bottles, jerseys or pinnies.
- In the event of an on-field injury, a family member and health care provider can attend to the player directly but all others must adhere to the 10 ft distancing.

Post-Competition

- Coaches must wipe down the metal benches utilized by players before departing.
- Coaches, players and spectators must social distance and leave the field and surrounding area promptly. Face coverings MUST be worn while exiting the field.
- Any coach, player or referee who participates in a game and receives a positive COVID-19 test within 14 days AFTER the game date, should communicate to the clubs involved immediately so all in attendance can be notified.
